Throughout the month of November, The Stormwater Division focused on drainageway improvements leading into the winter months along rights-of-way within the city. This included removing leaves and brush from drainage inlets/outlets. At the request of the Public Works Division, the Stormwater Division provided assistance on their projects that included erecting the City Christmas tree at City Hall. 
Notes: We repaired this area, but the hurricane came in and washed out the drainage. We repaired the system again by the road. The flex matting is work great.

WO120524002 – 538 Raymond Hirsch Pkwy, White House, TN (Sumner County)




Notes: Pine needles from upgradient pine trees clogged up the drainage pipe and required clean out.




Notes: We received a called about flooding. Upon inspection, a tree was blocking the area. The tree was removed to provide positive flow.

Notes: Resident reported complaints of water runoff from the road. After inspection, a water leak was identified and reported to WHUD. Leak was repaired and a runoff drainage system was added to help migrate water away from the home.

Notes: Homeowner requested dirt from the City to repair the depression created by neighbor removal of tree. Owner conducted work to grade dirt by themselves.

Notes: The Division cleaned out the drainage off of Pleasant Grove Road and added a new ditch line to allow positive stormwater flow.
