## **Rules & Regulations**

The following are not permitted in the dog park:

- Leaving dog waste without disposing it
- Children under the age of 10
- Children between the ages of 10 and 16 without adult supervision
- Any dog that exhibits or has a history of aggressive behavior
- Dogs without supervision
- Dogs without current registration and vaccination tags
- Spike, choke or prong collars
- Female dogs in heat
- Sick dogs
- Food, toys or glass containers
- More than three dogs per handler
- Smoking

Each handler is responsible for reading the rules upon entering the premises

A handler must be (16) years of age or older

Children between the ages of (10) and (16) may enter the park only with a responsible adult

For safety reasons, children under the age of (10) years old are prohibited from entering the fenced in area of the dog park

Disposal of dog waste, in the provided receptacles, is required

Dogs must be wearing (or handler carrying) current vaccination and registration tags at all times

- Handlers may be asked to present such items by proper authorities whenever deemed fit

Dogs must be leashed before entering and leaving the fenced area

Handlers are to have visual contact and verbal control of their dogs in the park

Dogs that become aggressive must be leashed and removed from the park immediately.

In no event shall a dog that has been designated as dangerous or vicious be brought into the park. The City of White House reserves the right to impose limitations, including restricting access to the dog park, for any aggressive dog and its owner.

Criminal penalties may apply to bringing a dangerous or vicious dog in this park.

Dog bites shall be reported immediately to the local police at 615-672-4903. All animal bites of other dogs or people shall be reported to local police and the animal control authority by anyone involved or witnessing the bite.

Handlers shall control excessive barking

Handlers are responsible for destruction caused by his or her dog, including the responsibility of filling in any holes dug while in the park, etc.
